Half of the Week 5 games went to OT on a sunny but windy Sunday at the halfway point of the NCHL season.

Bantam Division

Dr. Maahs beat Cullyvore Construction 6-5 in OT

Mason Wessel's overtime goal, his third of the game, led Dr. Maahs to a 6-5 overtime victory over Cullyvore Construction. **Evan Pemberton** scored two goals, while four players, including **Kyle Nelson** with two, and **Jack Fritz**, **Will Dexter**, and **Cody Dexter**, scored for Cullyvore Construction.

Wessel opened the scoring with a slapshot 2:28 into the opening frame, but Fritz tied it on an unassisted goal with 3:08 remaining as he spun and fired in a forehand.

Dr. Maahs regained the lead on a forehand wrist shot from Pemberton with 1:03 left in the first half. Cullyvore tied it at 2-2 when Cody Dexter fired in a low forehand :34 into the third.

Nik Gutierrez and **Alex Infanzon-Marin** had several scoring chances for Dr. Maahs, but **Trevor Crespo** and **Josh Morrell** were a wall in front of goalie **Brody Menzies**, who made 14 saves.

Dr. Maahs broke the tie halfway through the third period when Pemberton scored on a forehand through the 5-hole, and Weston

stretched the lead to 4-2 just :05 later when he rebounded a high Wessel slapshot.

Nelson, obviously inspired by his sister's success in the DoubleShot contest (or maybe threatened by the offer from coach Bryan Dexter to add her to the team?), fired in a rebound to cut it to 4-3 after 3 periods.

Just 1:05 into the final period, Will Dexter forced a turnover and got behind the defense to tie the score. And only :04 later Nelson scored his second goal on a rebound of a **Devin Menzies** shot to give Cullyvore Construction its first lead.

With time ticking down, Dr. Maahs pulled its goalie and the strategy worked as **Kion Mahrouzadeh** passed to Wessel, who fired in a forehand with :39.9 remaining to send the game into OT.

Kennedy Palmer and **Nik Gutierrez** helped protect Dr. Maahs goalie **Tyler Olson**, who turned aside 21 shots.

But 1:16 into overtime, Wessel scored his 7th goal of the season on a low wrister to win it for Dr. Maahs.

Bantam Division

Dr. Moody defeated Dr. Maahs 6-5 in OT

Brian Martinez one-timed a pass from **Joey Erdie** just :48 into overtime to give Dr. Moody a 6-5 win over Dr. Maahs in a see-saw battle. **Austin Murison** scored 3 goals and Erdie had a goal and 2 assists for Dr. Moody. **Patrick Weston** had a hat trick and **Mason Wessel** had 2 goals and one assist, while **Tyler Olson** made 30 saves for Dr. Maahs.

Erdie opened the scoring on a breakaway goal :59 into the game, and Murison scored the first of his 3 goals when he deked the goalie and tucked in a forehand. With just :52 left in the first Murison blazed in a high slapshot to give Dr. Moody a 3-0 lead.

Weston scored his first goal of the season as he took a pass from **Nik Gutierrez** and rifled in a high slapshot to make it 3-1 at the half. Wessel then scored on a pass from Gutierrez with 3:04 remaining in the third to cut the lead to 3-2.

Alex Infanzon-Marin and **Kennedy Palmer** halted the charges of **Joseph Overcashier** and **Scott Brovarney**, while **Connor Goodin** was denied by **James McKusick**. **Wesley Walters** played strong in front of Dr. Moody goalie **Jake Spaeth**, who made 14 saves.

The final 10 minutes saw a flurry of action. Dr. Maahs tied it just :03 into the fourth period when Weston rebounded his own shot. But **Evan Farbstein** regained the lead for Dr. Moody as he scored on a slapshot through the 5-hole after taking a touch pass from Erdie on a 2-on-1. With 2:13 left Wessel skated in and sent a pass from **Kion Mahrouzadeh** over the sprawling goalie.

With just 1:56 remaining in the game, Wessel fed Weston for his hat trick and Dr. Maahs' first lead of the day.

But Murison tied the game as scored his third goal with :55.4 left in regulation, as he skated by the goal, turned, and shot in a high forehand wristshot.

Olson made 13 fourth period saves but just :48 into overtime, Erdie stickhandled into the corner, spotted Martinez driving to the slot, and dropped a pass that he one-timed to the top of the net for a 6-5 win for Dr. Moody.

Coastside.net tied it on an unassisted goal by Tanner Dulay at the 4:30 mark of the first. With 2:59 remaining in the period, Kulda Construction regained the lead when Hunter Murison converted a pass from **Aidan Garcia**.

Sean Hicks and **Sam Vaughn** played tough defense in front of Coastside.net netminder **Noah Weinstein**, who made 12 first period saves, and 28 for the game. **Devin Rocha** and **Sean Donnellan** also worked hard to stymie the vaunted Kulda Construction offense of **Dylan Tighe** and Garcia, limiting the pair to only one assist.

Elchinoff tied it less than a minute into the second, but Baker scored on a scramble in front of the net after taking a pass from Murison to make it a 3-2 game.

Two goals in rapid succession gave Coastside.net the lead, as Elchinoff scored on a pass from **Tom Martin**, then scored an unassisted goal :08 later to make it 4-3 at the half.

Johnny Kennedy and **Jacob Winstead** made several rushes that were thwarted by **Joe Gutierrez**, who played lockdown defense in front of goalie **Carson Murison**, and Kulda Construction played a flawless second half.

At the 7:54 mark of the third, Jobe scored the first of his 3 goals on a forehand off a Hunter Murison pass, and a minute and a half later Baker deked the goal and put in a backhand to make it 6-4. The only goal of the final period was scored by Jobe, who converted a pass from Baker to give Kulda Construction the sweep of its two games on the day, and put the team atop the PeeWee division standings.
