Bantam Division

Dr. Moody defeated Dr. Maahs 3-2 in OT

Joey Erdie converted a 2-on-1 pass from Evan Farbstein with 2:05 left in overtime to give Dr. Moody the 3-2 win over Dr. Maahs. Wesley Walters opened the scoring :52 into the game

Alex Infanzon-Marin poked in a pass from Cody Hassler to tie the game. James McKusick scored on a slapshot from the right side to regain the lead with 1:33 left in the third.

With only :49 left in the fourth period, Nik Gutierrez evened the game as he shot in a wrist shot after a pass from Kennedy Palmer. The teams traded scoring chances in the extra session until Erdie scored his game-winning 13th goal of the season.

Playoff Preview: Team Capsules

Bantam Division

B3–Dr. Moody (Division Champion)

The Jesse Preciado-coached squad had an NCHL-high 9 wins and 52 goals-for in capturing the regular season crown. **Austin Murison** (21 goals) and **Joey Erdie** (13) went 1-2 in Bantam scoring. Solid defense from **Scott Brovarney** and **Joseph Overcashier**. Long reach of two-way forward **Evan Farbstein** a plus. Effective penalty-kill, giving up goals on only 3 of 8 chances.

Brian Martinez and **James McKusick** effective in executing neutral-zone trap. Standout stand-up goalie **Jake Spaeth** led the team to 4 overtime wins and lowest goals-against totals.

Hottest team; ended season on 7-game winning streak.

Prognosis: Expect a high-scoring affair with end-to-end action, but ready to win in overtime and capitalize on 4-0 OT record.

B1–Cullyvore Construction

The blue band of brothers bonded but bad luck and multiple absences ended the year. The Bryan Dexter-coached team was youngest in division but found stability, size and experience with **Josh Richards** and **Kyle Nelson**, who both finished in the top 5 in scoring. **Will Dexter**, when not minding the nets, added 6 goals. **Cody Dexter** and **Devin Menzies** were among the top 17 scorers. **Eoin Bloomer**, **Jack Fritz**, **Trevor Crespo** and **Josh Morrell** also lit the red light, and could find a seam in the play-offs.

Best conditioned team thanks to Joel Stewart's workout program. Red team needed the stamina as squad went to overtime in 6 of 10 games. Had 1-1 record in OT shootouts. Only 1 game decided by more than 1 goal. Team leader **Mason Wessel** had 13 points in 6 games. **Nick Moss** and **Patrick Weston** tied for 5th in the Division with 12 points each.

Sweepers **Kion Mahrouzadeh** and **Nik Gutierrez** were 8th and 9th in Bantam Division scoring. **Connor Goodin** and **Evan Pemberton** seldom turned loose at center but both capable of multiple goals. **Alex Infanzon-Marin** a clever skater. **Kennedy Palmer** played both ways effectively and **Richard Moss** and **Cody Hassler** improved steadily on defense throughout the year. Effective powerplay unit scored 4 of 6 times.

Netminder **Tyler Olson** a force in goal.

Prognosis: Expect a close match-up as 9 out of Dr. Moody's 10 games were decided by 1 goal.

PeeWee Division

P1–Lemos Farm (Division Champion)

Green was the color of money for the PeeWee Division champs. The Lemos Farmers boast a high-powered offense headed by PeeWee scoring co-leader **Chris Bradley**, who tallied 16 goals.

The PeeWee goal-scoring leaders also boasted a tight defense led by impenetrable goalie **Kian Kemp**.

Pace Farbstein led the second line with 11 goals, while **Zeb Miller** added 10 more. Sweeper **Frank Lemos** chipped in 5 while providing timely offense and defense.

Kezia Bowman led the PeeWees in assists from defense(wo)men. Defenders **Patrick Jones**, and **Kevin Welch** cleared the zone efficiently all season.

Defensive forwards **Allison Miller** and **Matthew Williams** were both effective in neutral zone.

Weakness could be on powerplay, as team converted only 1 of 6 chances. Squad overcame adversity on coaching flux situation to win final 4 games.

Prognosis: If coach remains out of sight, expect the team to find its scoring groove and acquit itself admirably.

P3–Coastside.net

Free-skating Jesse Preciado-coached offense with good size and multiple offensive weapons.

Rookie **Austin Elchinoff** tied for the PeeWee lead with 16 goals and 22 points in only 8 games. **Johnny Kennedy** tied for 4th with 11 goals. Big forwards **Sam Vaughn** and rookie **Tanner Dulay** lit the red light 5 times each. **Jacob Winstead** made his presence felt as he moved up a division. Won its only OT game in a shootout, and went 3-1 in games decided by 1 goal, proving it can win the close ones.

Stand-up rookie goalie **Noah Weinstein** got tough welcome but held up well under pressure against offensive-minded PeeWee Division. Defenseman **Sean Hicks** set up 3 goals, and paired with **Tom Martin** to clear the zone numerous times. **Sean Donnellan** was effective in neutralizing opposing goal-scorers.

Sharpshooter **Devlin Rocha** won one game with his shootout goal. Team scored 12 goals in last 3-game span, going 2-1.

Prognosis: If the game is close, expect the team to rally behind its solid play mid-rink, which should create scoring opportunities.

P2–Kulda Construction

Had strong mid-season run with 3-game winning streak as team gelled and found its offensive groove. **Elliot Baker** (12 goals), **Hunter Murison** (8) and **Curtis Jobe** (10) were 3-4-5 in PeeWee scoring.

Dylan Tighe scored 4 times in 7 games, and **Carson Murison** added a pair when not providing standout goaltending. **Aidan Garcia's** lethal slapshot lit the red light 4 times.

Rookie **Holden Hix** and **Joe Gutierrez** were solid on defense, while **Joe Quinlan** controlled the neutral zone in a sweeper role. Freshman **Jesse Batstone** showed flashes of immense skating ability in limited play.

Prognosis: Joel Stewart-coached teams always have a few surprises left for the post-season. Expect a solid effort from the red-clad speed demons.

Squirt Division

S3-Palladino Painting (Division Champion)

The Lou Palladino-coached offensive juggernaut scored a Squirt-high 29 goals. Chief among those who had the offense down A-Z were the high-octane scoring tandem of **Adam Mansell** and **Zane Cordero**, who each tallied 14 scores.

Team split goaltending duties effectively between numerous players including **Madeleine Mahrouzadeh** and **Graham Wylie**. **Amanda Weston** and **Maia Haley** played well in goal when not providing a wall on defense. **Antonio Roman** played hard in a league-high 12 games played and notched a goal.

Ben Wylie and **Marek Palladino** split shifts in sweeper roles, providing numerous offensive threats that enabled Palladino Painting to lead the division in scoring. Team had 29 goals, and scored 4 goals 3 times, while staying penalty-free all year.

Prognosis: Expect a high-tempo game as the squad looks to open up the rink and make it a fast-skating, free-wheeling affair.

S1-Dr. Stasun

The coach Mike Hovermale-designed defense was effective all season long, allowing a paltry 18 goals against. Started the year slow, with 2-3 record after 5 games, but finished 7-3. The rotating goalie trio of **Jessica Oseguera**, **Ben Bray** and **Zane Hovermale** had epiphany and stopped both opposing offenses cold. Team led NCHL with 3 shutout wins.

Morgan Hovermale and rookie **Dimitri Weinstein** finished in the top 10 in scoring for the only Squirt team that wasn't shut out all year. The gray-clad team put opponents into a gray fog at the end of the year with a 5-game winning streak. Won both its overtime contents, one on a shootout goal by **Indigo Kinzey**.

Newcomer **Rasmus Green** had 7 goals in 6 games, while rookie **Dexter Hamilton** made his presence felt in a sweeper role.

Gloria Oseguera and rookie **Griffen Dulay** obviously learned lessons from their older siblings as they were effective on defense.

Prognosis: Expect a shut-down defense and a low-scoring affair from the Pacifica skaters.

S2-Dr. Alborzi Black Wings

Wendy Padua-coached squad had 4-game point streak in mid-season but some bad luck in close games. Offense led by **Charlie Miller** (5 goals, 3 assists), who finished 3rd in Squirt scoring, and **North Cossman** and **Dominic Padua**, who scored 5 times each. Rookie **Billy Ginna** joined the team to provide stability on defense. Veteran **Ryan Wiler** added a powerful presence on defense and in goal, while **Luca Padua** displayed flashes of brilliant skating throughout the season.

Center **Liam Williams** and new skater **Peyton Pastorino** each also lit the red light at key times. Team scored 3 goals 5 times and never allowed more than 4 goals.

Prognosis: Smart money says team will turn around its 1-9 record in 1-goal games and catch a break, sending it deep into the post-season tourney.

The Year in Statistics

A total of 125 goals were scored in the Bantam division, 129 in PeeWee and 74 in Squirt. Talk about parity, each team had 2 scorers among the top 6 point leaders. Palladino Painting was never whistled for a penalty all year. Bonus hockey abounded, as overall the Bantams had 6 games go into Overtime, and Dr. Maahs was involved in all of them. The only PeeWee game that went to Overtime ended in a Shootout win by Coastside.net. The Squirts had 3 games go into overtime; one ended in a Shootout.

DoubleShot Contest Results

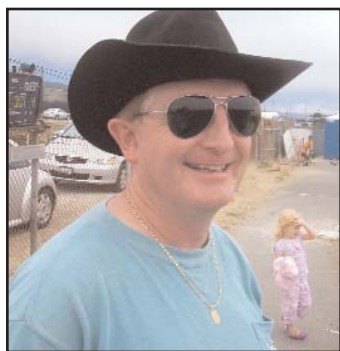
Highlights of our **DoubleShot Halftime Contest**:

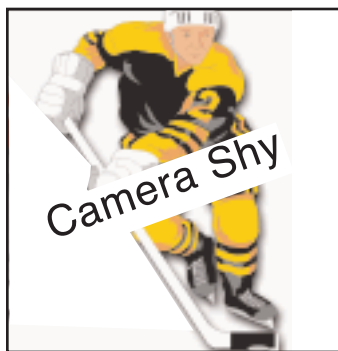
Other contestants during Week 8 included:
